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the forms furnished and shall be accompanied by a bid guarantee for an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid in accordance with the INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS.

The Village of Cohocton is exempt under New York State Tax law, and therefore, no sales tax on the cost of materials incorporated into the project shall be included in the bid.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish and pay for satisfactory performance and labor and material bonds in accordance with t h e I N S T R U C T I O N S T O B I D D E R S .

A Pre-Bid conference will be held at 1:30 p.m. local time on April 23 at

Village Offices at 17 South Main Street, Cohocton, NY 14826.

Representatives of Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the Project. Bidders are encouraged to attend and participate in the conference.
